Allocation of monthly quantity of 6,956.857 MTs of Rice, 9900.613 MTs of Wheat under NFSA and 8,492.824 MTs of Rice under Tide Over Allocation (OTNFSA) for the month of February, 2018.

Sir

The Govt. of India, Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Krishi Bhawan, New Delhi vide letter No. 1-8/2013-BP-III- (Vol.II) dated 21.02.2017 has allocated 6,956.857 MT Rice (AAY=2,627.888 MTs, PH= 4,328.969 MTs) and 9900.613 MT Wheat (AAY=3739.872 MTs, PHH=6160.741 MTs) under NFSA. Quantity of 8,492.824 MTs of Rice under Tide over allocation for consumers other than NFSA has also been allotted.

The District wise/PDC's wise sub allocation of the above quantity for the month of February, 2018 is made as per annexure attached, the financial arrangements for which shall be made by the Managing Director, H.P. State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd., Shimla. No diversion of quantities be executed in the allocation so made except with prior approval of the undersigned that too as an exception and not as a rule.



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
