Regarding issuance of backlog quota of ration to the consumers.
Sir,

It has been observed that sometimes because of certain reasons, delayed supplies of essential commodities to fair price shops by the HP State Civil Supplies Corporation leads to creation of backlog quota of ration. The matter regarding providing of backlog quota to consumers was under the consideration of the department for some time past and was taken up with the Govt.

The Govt. vide letter No. FDS-C(1)1/2014 dated 5.12.2017 has conveyed the approval that ration card holders of the State will henceforth be issued the backlog quota of their ration upto a maximum period of three months. In case, a ration card holder visits fair price shop to draw his ration in 3rd month, he will be issued backlog of his ration quota for the preceding 2 months and quota of current month. For instance, a ration card holder has not drawn his ration for the month of October, November, 2017 and he comes to FPS to draw his ration in December, 2017, he will be provided backlog quota of his ration for October & November, 2017 with ration quota of December, 2017. His backlog quota of October, 2017 will stand lapsed in January, 2018 if not lifted in December, 2017. Thus, no ration card holder will be issued ration quota for a period exceeding 3 months at a time.

In view of the above, there will be no change in quantity of ration to be issued to fair price shop holder for first three consecutive months. After every 3 months, ration will be supplied to the fair price shop holder after adjusting the balances. In addition to this, 5% buffer stock may also be allowed with the fair price shop holders after three months.
